



This process is not merely about providing help to those in need; it involves actively collaborating with community members to create meaningful change alongside them.

For example, it might involve creating educational programmes that equip people with essential vocational skills, encouraging local entrepreneurship, or improving public transport systems to ensure everyone has mobility. It could also include initiatives aimed at enhancing healthcare facilities and services, promoting environmental sustainability through community gardening projects, or supporting inclusive dialogues that empower marginalised voices. The list is endless. In principle, the idea of uplifting communities sparks our imagination, but what does it look like in real-world contexts?

RELATIONSHIP BUILDING

Genuine community upliftment requires a commitment to creating enduring relationships, understanding local needs, and working together to create a shared vision for a better future. Christian organisations are widely recognised for uplifting communities worldwide, including in South Africa. Their efforts often comprise social, economic, educational, and spiritual projects. Sadly, mainstream media does not share enough information with the public

about how Christian organisations make a difference. While Christians believe that the "right hand must not know what the left hand is doing" when it comes to helping others, we have a responsibility to glorify the Lord by sharing information with the world about how the Lord uses people and organisations for His glory. These positive stories are uplifting and give hope.

A well-known example in South Africa that genuinely benefits communities and glorifies the Lord through its work is the multiaward-winning water bottling brand, aQuellé. It is community-based and exists as a profitable enterprise because of the community it serves. This water brand is bottled on the farm of the Christian Mission, KwaSizabantu, located in the Kranskop area near Greytown in KwaZulu-Natal's (KZN) Midlands region. The area features a rocky escarpment with scenic value. However, it remains predominantly rural and faces many socio-economic challenges, such as limited infrastructure, few employment opportunities, poverty, and restricted access to essential services. Against this background, aQuellé actively plays a role in making life better for its community. Despite the challenges, aQuellé, in collaboration with partners, local leadership and community organisations, has been proactive in establishing sustainable solutions that enhance development KwaSizabantu is self-sustainable, and the mission's work and upliftment programmes are funded by enterprises it has established over the years, reducing reliance on external donations. The Mission

has created thousands of jobs in the area through its diverse commercial ventures, including the aQuellé bottled water company, which has three plants in different regions. Here is a profile explaining a few reasons why and how aQuellé exemplifies community upliftment.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

aQuellé has played a vital role in providing relief during crises such as the 2022 floods in KZN. The company distributed food, water, and water tanks to communities without access to clean water. To mark its 25th anniversary, aQuellé launched a campaign to donate 25 water tanks to underserved communities. It is an ongoing project. These tanks offer a sustainable source of fresh water for schools and residents.

The first water tank in the series was installed at Aldinville Primary School in KwaDukuza, KZN, on Tuesday, 30 July 2024. Michael Ngubane, director of aQuellé, said at the occasion, "Access to safe and clean drinking water is a challenge for many communities. In addition, frequent floods in recent years have caused significant damage to municipal water supply systems, leading to a water crisis. This is why aQuellé has come here to help. We brought the school a large tank of water, and the children can be happy as they come to school." Thanks to aQuellé, there are already 25 donated water tanks in various locations, each containing 5,000 litres of fresh water. These tanks are fitted with user-friendly taps, providing a reliable and sustainable water supply. This ensures that community members and schoolchildren have easy access to safe drink-

ing water.

ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL PROJECTS

One of aQuellé's outstanding projects is its clean-ups. The initiative focuses on community involvement and ecological indicator education. It is a nationwide programme aimed at improving the environment and communities, significantly affecting neighbourhoods. Launched in 2021, the programme focuses on sustainable waste management, community engagement, and environmental education. It has conducted nearly 100 cleanup activities in neglected areas across all provinces, making it one of the country's most extensive and sustainable community-led ecological efforts. These projects have attracted tens of thousands of volunteers, including residents, schools, municipalities, and environmental agencies.

Each cleanup event is organised in partnership with local municipalities, community groups, and other stakeholders. The initiative emphasises the importance of reducing, reusing, and recycling to minimise waste and environmental impact. In so doing, the community benefits in many ways. Participating in clean-up campaigns promotes environmental responsibility and educates community members about the importance of reducing, reusing, and recycling to minimise waste sent to landfills. Through collaborations with local media such as Radio Khwezi, aQuellé informs communities about the benefits of recycling and proper waste management.

aQuellé financially supports the KwaSizabantu bi-annual week-long youth conferences, of which 102 have been held since it started over 50 years ago. Attended by thousands of young people at a time, these events provide social connection, spiritual encouragement, volunteer involvement, leadership and skills development.

To help develop fundamental skills, aQuellé partners with Emseni Farming (another KwaSizabantu enterprise) to establish vegetable gardens at schools. Dietmar Joosten, the farm manager of Emseni, said he hopes it will inspire young people to explore agriculture. "I want to encourage you to grow your vegetable gardens so you can help care for your families," Dietmar told the young people at a youth conference where thousands of seedlings were distributed to kickstart their agricultural efforts. "In this way, you can help yourselves, and you can also help others. Maybe you can later pursue careers in food security." These youth conferences highlighted social issues and youth challenges, leading to the CYPSA (Concerned Young People of SA) initiative, which supports young people facing addictions and other difficulties. With financial backing from aQuellé, which alleviates the financial burdens for those most in need, over 20,000 people have already received help with their addictions.

NOAH'S ARK

History, Hope, and the Picture of the Rapture




Few accounts in Scripture are as well-known as the story of Noah's Ark. Children learn of it in Sunday school, skeptics question it, and scientists search for evidence of it. Yet, far beyond being a tale for children, Noah's Ark is a foundational account in the Bible that speaks of God's justice, His mercy, and His plan for salvation. In this article, we will explore three key aspects: evidence for the Ark and the global flood, how Noah's Ark foreshadows the Rapture of the Church, and fascinating flood traditions from cultures around the world.

1. Did Noah's Ark Really Happen? Scientific and Biblical Evidence

Biblical Testimony

The Bible records in Genesis 6–9 that God judged the world through a flood because of the great wickedness of humanity. Noah, a righteous man, was commanded to build an ark to save his family and representatives of all living creatures. Jesus Himself affirmed the historical reality of Noah's day: "As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man" (Matthew 24:37). The New Testament writers—Peter and the author of Hebrews—also refer to Noah as a real figure of faith (Hebrews 11:7; 2 Peter 2:5).



Scientific Evidence

Global Flood Legends: More than 200 cultures worldwide—spanning from Mesopotamia to the Americas, from Africa to Asia—preserve flood accounts. Many of these describe a catastrophic deluge, a vessel, and the survival of eight people. Geological Signs: Layers of sedimentary rock found across continents suggest rapid, large-scale water coverage. Marine fossils appear high in mountain ranges (e.g., the Himalayas), pointing to a time when oceans once covered much of the earth.

Archaeological Interest: Mount Ararat in Turkey (the traditional resting place of the Ark) remains a site of intrigue. While no discovery has been universally accepted as the Ark, reported sightings and expeditions continue to stir discussion.

Engineering Feasibility: Studies show the Ark's biblical dimensions (about 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high) create an ideal ratio for stability in rough waters. Modern shipbuilders have confirmed that such dimensions would have been seaworthy.

2. How Did All the Animals Fit on the Ark?
Skeptics often ask how Noah could possibly fit "all the animals" on the
Ark. Several explanations help us understand:

- Kinds, Not Species: The Bible says God brought two of every "kind" of animal, not every species we know today. A "kind" could represent a broader category, from which today's species descended. This would drastically reduce the number of animals needed.
- Young Animals or Eggs: It is possible God brought young animals—smaller in size, easier to manage, and requiring less food. Some creatures may even have been preserved in egg form.
- Supernatural Provision: God, who orchestrated the entire event, may have allowed the animals to enter a state similar to hibernation. This would reduce their need for food, water, and care during the year-long stay on the Ark.

Taken together, these explanations show that the Ark had more than enough room. With three decks and massive square footage, Noah's Ark could easily house animals, food, and Noah's family.

God's Promise: The Rainbow of Covenant

After the floodwaters subsided, Noah built an altar and offered sacrifices of thanksgiving to the Lord. God then made a covenant promise never again to destroy the earth with a flood. As a sign of this everlasting covenant between Himself and all living creatures, God placed a rainbow in the sky (Genesis 9:12–17).

The rainbow stands as a powerful reminder of: God's Mercy and Faithfulness: Though He judged the world, He also remembered mercy. A Universal Covenant: The promise was not only to Noah, but to all

generations and all creation.

A Symbol of Hope: Even after the storm, God's light shines through. The rainbow is a visible expression of His grace.

Spiritually, the rainbow also points to Christ—our mediator of a better covenant (Hebrews 8:6). Just as the rainbow bridges heaven and earth, Jesus bridges God and humanity, offering peace and reconciliation.



3. Noah's Ark and the Rapture of the Church
The Ark is more than history—it is prophecy in picture. The New
Testament connects Noah's days with the coming judgment at the
end of the age.

Deliverance Before Judgment: Just as Noah and his family were lifted above the waters of destruction, the Church will be "caught up" (raptured) before the final judgment of the earth (1 Thessalonians 4:16–17).

A Call to Readiness: In Matthew 24:38–39, Jesus warns that people in Noah's day were eating, drinking, and unaware until the flood came. Likewise, many will be unprepared when Christ returns.

The Ark as Christ: Noah's Ark itself points to Christ. Only one door led into safety (Genesis 6:16), just as Jesus is "the door" (John 10:9). All who entered the Ark were saved; all who enter through Christ will escape eternal judgment.

The message is clear: God provides a way of salvation, but only those who respond in faith will be rescued.

4. Fascinating Facts: Noah, His Family, and Global Flood Stories

Noah and His Family

Noah lived to be 950 years old (Genesis 9:29).

He was a preacher of righteousness (2 Peter 2:5), warning the world for decades while building the Ark.

Only eight souls entered the Ark: Noah, his wife, his three sons (Shem, Ham, Japheth), and their wives. These eight became the ancestors of all post-flood humanity.

Global Flood Stories

Remarkably, stories of a great flood appear across many cultures:

Mesopotamia (Epic of Gilgamesh): Describes a boat, a righteous man, animals, and a flood sent by the gods.

Native American Tribes: Cherokee and Aztec traditions tell of a family saved in a large canoe.

China: Ancient flood legends tell of a catastrophic deluge survived by a man, his wife, three sons, and three daughters.

Hawaiian Tradition: Speaks of Nu'u, who built an ark to escape a global flood with his family.

These widespread accounts, though varying in details, point back to a common historical event remembered by humanity.







THE GOSPEL MESSAGE

Romans 3:23 ESV

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"

The abovementioned verse is an extremely well used verse and many people know it and can even quote it off by heart, but the significance of it is the reality that every single person needs to contemplate.

If you have not accepted Jesus as your Personal Saviour yet or are thin king about it, you have to start here. The reality of your sin problem cancels and disqualifies you from the very presence of God and this bars you from eternal Life. Your choices are simple here, either an eternity with God or an Eternity without God. I would think that the logical answer would be an Eternity with God. Why? Well let's look at this:

2 Thessalonians 1:9

Wow! Just look at this, not only do we get Eternal Life but we become Children of God. The impact of this is massive as it speaks to the fact that we now belong to the family of God and receive the benefits of being part of a family, and not just any family but a royal family (1 Peter 2 vs 9).

So in looking and understanding all of this, How do you accept Jesus as your Personal Saviour?

Romans 10 vs 9-10

"that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; 10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation."

NASB

Let me just make one point very clear before we look at the above verses, your salvation cannot be obtained by good works, you cannot go to Heaven or be part of God's family because you are a good person, or you do good deeds, No! The Bible makes it clear, if you want to accept Jesus as your Personal Saviour then it gets done on the basis of two things. FEASTS OF ANCIENT TIMES

The three major Pilgrimage Festivals in Hebrew ("shalosh Regalim") are three major festivals in Judaism. They are:

- 1) The Passover Feast ("Pesach")
- 2) The Feast of Pentecost or Feast of Weeks ("Shavuot")
- 3) The Feast of Tabernacle or Feast of Tents/Booths ("Sukkot")

Ancient Israelites living in the kingdom of Judah, made a Pilgrimage to the Temple in Jerusalem as was commanded by the Torah. Let us have a look at Exo 23:14-17 Three times in the year you shall keep a feast to Me. Exo 23:15 You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread ("matzos"); seven days you shall eat unleavened bread as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt.

None shall appear before Me empty-handed. Exo 23:16 Also you shall keep the Feast of Harvest [Pentecost]- ("Shavuot"), [acknowledging] the first fruits of your toil, of what you sow in the field. And [third] you shall keep the Feast of Ingathering [Booths or Tabernacles] – ("Sukkot") at the end of the year, when you gather in the fruit of your labours from the field. Exo 23:17 Three times in the year all your males shall appear before the Lord God.

Also have a look at the **Book of Deuteronomy**:

The Feast of Passover: Deu 16:1 Observe the month of Abib and keep the Passover to the Lord your God, for in the month of Abib the Lord your God brought you out of Egypt by night. The Feast of Weeks: Deu 16:9 You shall count seven weeks; begin to number the seven weeks from the time you begin to put the sickle to the standing grain. Deu 16:10 Then you shall keep the Feast of Weeks to the Lord your God with a tribute of a freewill offering from your hand, which you shall give to the Lord your God, as the Lord your God blesses you. The Feast of Booths: Deu 16:13 You shall observe the Feast of Tabernacles or Booths for seven days after you have gathered in from your threshing floor and wine vat. Deu 16:16 Three times a year shall all your males appear before the Lord your God in the place which He chooses: at the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles or Booths.

They shall not appear before the Lord empty-handed: Deu 16:17 Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the Lord your God which He has given you. In Jerusalem they came to worship God; bring Offerings; participate in festivities and worship rituals through the services of Priests ("kohanim") in the Temple. After destruction of the

second Temple Pilgrimages were no longer compulsory to the Jews. Today in modern Israel, many Jews living in or near Jerusalem try to attend Prayer Services at the Western Wall, probably trying to keep the ancient tradition alive. Did you know that Samaritans, even till today, take Pilgrimages to Mount Gerizim three times a year?

GEMS IN THE WORD OF GOD

There are many Gems in the Word of God of which we can learn much because every Gem has a significant colour and meaning, physical and spiritual. The garment of the High-Priest (Exo 28:19-21) of the old ancient Temples, had twelve different stones in his Breastplate. Every stone represented a tribe of Israel as well as a special colour and refer to each of the twelve Disciple of Jesus in the New Testament. Exo 28:15 You shall make a breastplate of judgment, in skilled work; like the workmanship of the ephod shall you make it, of gold, blue, purple, and scarlet [stuff], and of fine twined linen. Exo 28:16 The bbreastplate shall be square and doubled; a span [nine inches] shall be its length and a span shall be its breadth. Exo 28:17 You shall set in it four rows of stones: a sardius, a topaz, and a carbuncle shall be the first row; Exo 28:18 The second row an emerald, a sapphire, and a diamond [so called at that time]; Exo 28:19 The third row a jacinth, an agate, and an

amethyst;

Exo 28:20 And the fourth row a beryl, an onyx, and a jasper; they shall be set in gold filigree. Exo 28:21 And the stones shall be twelve, according to the names of the sons of Israel, like the engravings of a signet, each with its name for the twelve tribes.

In the New Testament we find the gems also mentioned in the Book of Revelation. Rev 21:19 The foundation [stones] of the wall of the city were ornamented with all the precious stones. The first foundation [stone] was jasper, the second sapphire, the third chalcedony (or white agate), the fourth emerald, [Isa. 54:11, 12.] Rev 21:20 The fifth onyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, the twelfth amethyst. Rev 21:21 And the twelve gates were twelve pearls, each separate gate being built of one solid pearl. And the main street (the Broadway) of the city was of gold as pure and translucent as glass. METALS IN GOD'S WORD

The Bible of God's Word mentions six metals: copper, gold, silver, lead, tin, and iron.

Num 31:21 And Eleazar the priest said to the men of war who had gone to battle, This is the statute of the law which the Lord has commanded Moses: Num 31:22 Only the gold, the silver, the bronze, the iron, the tin, and the lead, Num 31:23 Everything that can stand fire, you shall make go through fire, and it shall be clean. Nevertheless, it shall also be purified with the water of impurity; and all that cannot stand fire [such as fabrics] you shall pass through water.

Note the following interesting factors:

What is the rarest metal of all?

Whereas "Tantalum" is the rarest stable metal on earth; the rarest metal on earth is "Francium" but it is very unstable and has a lifespan of only 22 minutes, therefor it serves no purpose.

Is there a metal worth more than Gold?

From the four major metals, Palladium is now the most valuable. But due to much shortage thereof the prices have shot through the roof. Palladium is a key component in pollution control devices for trucks and cars, and the price has doubled in less than a year, making it more expensive than Gold.

What is the oldest metal in the world?

In the Middle East, some Researchers declared that they have found the oldest metal object dating back to the late 6th or 5th century BC:

It is called copper awl, found at "Tel Tsaf" excavation site near the border of Israel, in Jordan.



What is the strongest metal in the world?

In terms of flexibility, Tungsten is the strongest of any natural metal (142,000 psi). But with regards to impact strength, it will shatter on impact due to brittleness.

When did Humans start using metals first?

Copper was apparently used by ancient man more than 10000 years ago – a copper pendant was discovered in 8700bC in where modern Northern Iraq is now. Although various copper tools and artifacts can support this claim, some Archaeologists give evidence that the early Mesopotamians were the first to fully harness the ability to extract and work with copper. Copper had all the metal applications and for almost five millennia it was the only metal known to man. During the next 2000

years humans have learnt where to find metals, how to master them, and manipulate them for their own selfish usage. Nuggets of gold were the easiest to find in streams, etc.

Who were the first to make steel?

Around 400bC Indian metalworkers invented a "smelting process" which bonded the perfect amount of carbon to iron; therefore, producing the first true steel. Their secret was a clay that was receptable for the molten metal, a Crucible. By the height of the Roman Empire, many metals were in use including silver, zinc, mercury, lead, gold, copper, tin, iron, arsenic and antimony.

Who were the first to use Iron?

Iron objects were found in Egypt dating back as far as 3500bC, containing 7.5% nickel, indicating they were of meteoric origin. Iron is found in the core of all Planets in the Solar System and is the heaviest element formed inside Stars.

Is there a metal that is Bulletproof?

By melting aluminum around hollow metal spheres, composite metal foam is 70% lighter than sheet metal and can absorb 80 times more energy than steel. Aluminum is fireproof, radiation-resistant, and bulletproof.

Is there something like a "holy metal"?

The word Iron comes from earlier words meaning "holy metal" because it was used to make swords that was used in the Crusades. In Hinduism, their religion believe that gold was the first human, therefore gold is the "holiest metal" according to Hindu's.

SILVER

Gen 23:15 My lord, listen to me. The land is worth 400 shekels of silver; what is that between you and me?

TIN

Num 31:22 Only gold, silver, bronze, iron, tin, and the lead, IRON Deu 8:9 A land in which you shall eat food without shortage and lack nothing in it; a land whose stones are iron and out of whose hills you can dig copper.


