TANJA DE MEILLON: AT FACE VALUE

I remember singing a Caren Carpenter song at the top of my voice from the veranda of our home: “I’m on the top of the world, looking down at creation and the only explanation I can find, is the love that I found ever since you’ve been around, your love put me at the top of the world”. I was 11 and a very happy girl. In my heart, I was directing the song to the God who saved my heart - ever since You’ve been around, Your love.... I had given my heart to Jesus at the age of 5. I was at a Sunday School service and I knew that I needed this wonderful Friend in my heart. He had come to be with me through the journey of my life – little did I know how much this friendship would mean.

At the age of 42, I had my book published: FACE VALUE. I had gone through the kind of stuff in my life that the enemy typically uses to crush identity and self-worth. I had had enough of the fear, shame and guilt that had gripped me since my first encounter with the broken world we live in. December 1985. I was so excited to go with my bestie on holiday after finishing with primary school! Her grandparents were taking us on a special trip to the seaside and it would be my first holiday without my parents. I remember little spots of details, but the rest became a blur after a seriously traumatic event, left us both trembling back in the apartment. The hotel was right on the beach front, and we had wrapped our towels around us and were heading back to the apartment, when a man met us at the entrance to the hotel. He convinced us that he worked as a photographer for a modeling agency and that we looked like girls who should be in magazines! He offered to take a few pics of us in his studio higher up in the building.... The strangest thing is that a little voice deep inside was sending signals of warnings, but I was so taken up with my friend’s excitement and the possible opportunity, that I had myself led to the

lift which took us high up to top floor areas. Another man climbed into the lift with us when we got in, and he got out with us when we had reached the destination. By the time we had got out of the lift and I saw all the empty office spaces, I knew instinctively that this was wrong. It was too late for 11 year-olds to fight their way out of this. We were like sheep lead to be slaughtered, each taken by one of the men. When they were done, they let us run. I have no idea how we found the stairs and figured out how to get to our apartment, but we found ourselves heaving for breath in the bathroom, very ready to wash ourselves. I felt dirty, guilty, shamed and in such fear, that we made a promise to each other that we would tell no one of the incident! We felt in very big trouble for it and I for one could not handle the disgrace that would come from it, and the thought of my parents finding out, felt devastating.

We were too young to understand that keeping silent does not make the worst unhappen. I cried myself to sleep that night... and many, many nights thereafter. It felt like a great sadness fell over me. I was going through the teenage years and my body was trying to express the trauma from within. I had no idea how the suppressed anger, fear, guilt and shame had weaved their way into the biggest organ of the body: the skin! It was like watching an evil war on the outside of me, teasing me every time I looked in the mirror. Reminding me of the terrible choice I made that day! All the replays in my mind at night when the house was dark and quiet – was torturing. Being trapped inside an invisible prison with no one to talk to. I only had my Friend, with whom, I was now also experiencing a strained relationship. I would just utter His Name at night, and WHY??? Why me, why He did not prevent it and protect me! The enemy used the trauma, as is his

best game plan, to create a wedge between my Friend and I. Life in its broken form, had come at me. At my lowest point the enemy was right there at night to bring the doubts of God's goodness, greatness, love, kindness – all the attributes that I was learning about Him in Sunday school and church. The enemy knew that I was broken, hurt, angry and he knew this to be the great recipe he uses to twist our identities in God and about God into a place of confusion, doubt and a horrible feeling of being rejected by the greatest Love of all.

My book was titled 'Face Value' for the reason that I knew how to hide my pain for many years. We all see others this way most of the time, little knowing what is truly going on behind the smiles. I smiled, greeted, sang, played the trumpet, prayed, and left the church building to go to my safest place – my bedroom. My parents understood my attitude of withdrawal at home, to be the typical hard teen years. To give an example of how the enemy twists our view on life: I overheard my parents discussing the issue with my skin and I heard my dad say that they would get hold of a doctor to fix it! Now they were doing what perfect parents do: they were finding a solution to a problem for their beloved daughter. What I heard in my heart though, was that I was not good enough, if I did not look good enough. The enemy was pushing his agenda, that my identity had to be based on performance, perfection, acceptance of others. He was using my disposition and the awkwardness of the brokenness that I was in, to undo Truth in me, to embed lies into my soul so that it would settle in to my very nature. Situations were happening around me, that 'proved' to me that he was right! I was no more on the top of the world. I was crawling on the lowest, deepest, darkest place, just breathing to survive!

Forgiving someone for causing great pain and the years of being bound in that pain, can only come from God. He led me to it, and also through it. I experienced how He held me close as I closed my eyes and uttered the words that came through tight lips at first. Then I repeated the words over and over and the sadness of many years of suppressed anger, flowed down my face. I somehow understood His love for the first time, In a deeper and more tangible

way. I had come to know the experience of being set free! My book is filled with some of life's most unwanted experiences – my father dying in my arms, experiencing betrayal in my first marriage, the sudden death of my husband at the age of 36, single parenting challenges, 2 nd marriage ending in divorce... the kind of things that break us. However, as written on the back of my book: ‘...many times in life we are inside circumstances that seem to overwhelm and have us feel like there is no hope, no end. It will usually feel like this. Reason being, we have lost perspective. We only see a part and not the whole. Perspective is an amazing skill to acquire in life. It's a knowing that no matter what, there is a bigger picture than the moment. It's a piece of the puzzle – a chapter in the book of my life. This, has been an anchor to me throughout the many trials of life.

I know the Author and Finisher of our lives is in control of every circumstance and every moment and He will complete the good work which He has began in us.” I truly know that Romans 8:28 is true – that He is able to work ALL things for the good of those who love Him. Today I oversee children's ministry in our church – AFM Deo Doxa. It is a great passion for me to raise giants in the Kingdom of God. I know that the enemy comes as early as possible to kill, steal and destroy but he cannot stand against the power of Truth! Truth sets free. The Word is Truth. The Word is what they get. Fun, games and play is a part – but I am serious about the seed of the Word which needs to be sown early in their lives. In a part of my book, I also explain how it is that I got into pageantry. After the many years of hiding in my room, I had ironically come to enjoy the bright lights and stages! The challenge and growth in the process, the sharpened skills that I was unaware of and gifts that I never knew I had. I find it interesting that the very area in which the

enemy was aiming to destroy me, was the industry and area that I work in today. I have been a beauty therapist for the past 30 years! God gave me a special missions field, as within the many thousands of hours of conversation within my cubicle, I have had the grace to share His heart and goodness with a soul in need. A next chapter: with the age of 53 being the cut-off age, it was just too much of an invitation, not to take the leap into another adventurous journey! I am also thankful about the prospect of working for a great cause and one which also lies close to my heart. In this Mrs Universe South Africa platform, we are advocating against domestic violence and abuse. We as Semi finalists will be hosting charity events in supporting causes that speak to the heart of our broken world in this way. It is a privilege to work on various projects like this to make that light shine even brighter.

For those who may feel lost, hopeless, hurt or confused – take heart, there is One who has overcome the world! We live in a very high-tech, solutions driven world that offers many forms of healing. Some may offer help and alleviate the condition. I advocate for the true Healer of the soul – the only One who can heal a broken heart and set a captive free. I pray that you get to know Him because He certainly knows and loves you!

Michael Ngubane discovered a profound sense of grace, a turning point that inspired him to dedicate his life entirely to the work of God.

Michael Ngubane is the deputy station manager at Radio Khwezi and has an inspiring story that led him to the KwaSizabantu Mission. Initially seeking help for his many problems and not a Christian, he was brought to the Mission by a family member. What was intended as a brief visit for assistance became a commitment to the Lord's work. For more than four decades, KwaSizabantu has been his permanent home, marking the start of his transformative journey of purpose and devotion.

He was an alcoholic and, at the age of seventeen, stabbed someone with a knife. The person died as a result. It was a difficult time for him, and he considered taking his own life. He went to the police and reported it. Someone accompanied him, and he was put in jail. While he was in prison for a few months, he was bailed out, and then one of his aunts told him about the KwaSizabantu Mission, which helps troubled people like him.

ARRIVING AT THE MISSION, A TROUBLED YOUNG MAN

When Michael arrived at the mission station, he was a troubled young man, feeling lost and alone. During a service, he was struck by the preacher's message, believing everyone knew his story. Later, he realised it was God reaching out to him. After a prayer with a counsellor, Michael accepted the Lord and began to change his life. Michael said, "People can say whatever they want, but I know that I am where I am supposed to be. These people accepted me for who I am, with all my mistakes and wrong choices". One night, he had a dream in which a person was preaching to him and reading from the Bible. He read 1 John

2:1-2 (NIV): “My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have an advocate with the Father – Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world”. He realised that the Lord was his advocate. He went to Eshowe and appeared before a judge. He was called in, and the judge asked him whether he had done all the things he was accused of. Michael then confessed to all he had done. He also told the judge he found the Lord. The Judge then said that if he were taken to jail, it would not help him. That was a sign for him that the Lord is his judge, and he committed himself to serving the Lord from that day on. He kept that promise until this day.

RADIO KHWEZI – A NEW PURPOSE

Michael is currently the deputy station manager at Radio Khwezi, a community radio station based at the mission station. Daniel Wunderlich, the station manager, has great respect for Michael’s contribution to the station. He said: Michael Ngubane is not only an excellent producer and presenter for some of the isiZulu programs; he is also like an older brother to me. I never make an important decision without seeking his advice. His experience and farsightedness are invaluable”.

Michael recalls the early days when the station was still struggling to find its feet: “The radio station took us from nothing to great heights. After 1995, progress began. It all revolves around the founder, the late Rev Erlo Stegen, a man with a vision. He had a strong faith and believed that the

Lord answered his prayers because of his devotion. His motto was, ‘Use what you have, start something, and make the best of it.’ “One day, he was flying in an aircraft and saw many houses. It made him wonder how to reach those people with the gospel. He asked those around him for advice, and they advised him to record the KwaSizabantu services, which would then be sent out as sermons. That was the first plan to build a recording studio, not a radio station. He started doing that, built a studio, and made sure it was soundproof. It was not long before an opportunity arose for a community radio station, and Rev Stegen immediately applied. Radio Khwezi was the first to be given a licence for a community radio station. Then Rev Stegen told me that I should ‘talk’ at the station. That is how I ended up at Radio Khwezi. Before that, I was a counsellor, but I had no broadcasting experience.”

“This station was established in a place where God is at work. We have the infrastructure and the talent to write stories and dramas. There are many people here with diverse skills, and it is evident that God is at work in their lives. We are producing many programmes. You can see that the people here do what they do with their hearts.” “A challenge we faced was a profound question: ‘Who hears us?’ Driven by this inquiry, we set out to share Radio Khwezi’s story with our community. We ventured into the heart of our neighbourhoods, engaging with residents and spreading the word about our station. It was no easy feat; we encountered obstacles and doubts along the way, but our determination prevailed. Slowly but surely, Khwezi’s voice began to resonate, and many people started tuning in.

“When they told us in 2025 that we had been nominated 19 times and announced that we had won Radio Station of the Year (for the second time), we knew we were doing things right. We do what we do for the listeners and for our community. We emphasise this to our staff as well. We don’t stop asking for help. We ask our universities for help. We say that a person must have the radio in their heart to be part of our team.

“I am deeply grateful to our dedicated staff. Some join us for training, their initial intent merely to learn, yet many choose to stay, drawn by our mission. We’ve built a community of like-minded individuals who share one common goal: to serve and uplift our neighbours. Our purpose transcends personal ambition; we are here entirely for the betterment of those around us, committed to fostering connections and empowering every voice in our community. Our listener’s club is a good example. They regularly help us, for instance, by assisting during our annual youth conferences.” “It is wonderful to interact with our loyal listeners; they have a strong desire to help others. If they see someone in need, they want to lend a hand. To serve our community effectively, we need unity. That unity exists among our staff members, between staff and management, and between management and board members.” “My message to your readers is: Tune in. You can also tune in online, and you are invited to interact.” My interview with Michael Ngubane was one of the highlights of my life. His passion, dedication and commitment to the Lord’s work are a tribute to the steadfast character of an honest man who acknowledged his mistakes and corrected them.

THE GOSPEL MESSAGE

Romans 3:23 ESV

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"

The abovementioned verse is an extremely well used verse and many people know it and can even quote it off by heart, but the significance of it is the reality that every single person needs to contemplate.

If you have not accepted Jesus as your Personal Saviour yet or are thin king about it, you have to start here. The reality of your sin problem cancels and disqualifies you from the very presence of God and this bars you from eternal Life. Your choices are simple here, either an eternity with God or an Eternity without God. I would think that the logical answer would be an Eternity with God. Why? Well let's look at this:

2 Thessalonians 1:9

"They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might"

NASB

This is the reality of a choice that omits Jesus as your Personal Saviour -

- = **Everlasting Punishment**
- = **Destruction**
- = **Shut Out**
- = **No Godly Presence**
- = **And no Glory at all**

This is not something to take lightly and by the way this is not scaring you into making a false decision, God is love, thus we as His followers are love, this means if I say I have the love of God, it is my duty to tell you the truth and point you into the right direction.

So in looking at the sin problem and the reality of this, what is the answer then? Let's look at this:

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

NASB

What a wonderful solution to an immense problem, God has made a way and in making the way He has also made it very clear that this is the only answer to the problem. You have to accept Jesus His Son in order to obtain Eternal Life and ward off all the destruction and other bad things spoken about in the previous Bible verse.

It also makes it very clear that this can only be done through JESUS CHRIST His Son, there is no other way to salvation or Eternal life other than through Jesus, NONE!

Let's look at this too:

John 1:12-13

"But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God."

NASB

Wow! Just look at this, not only do we get Eternal Life but we become Children of God. The impact of this is massive as it speaks to the fact that we now belong to the family of God and receive the benefits of being part of a family, and not just any family but a royal family (1 Peter 2 vs 9).

Romans 10 vs 9-10

"that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; 10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation."

NASB

Let me just make one point very clear before we look at the above verses, your salvation cannot be obtained by good works, you cannot go to Heaven or be part of God's family because you are a good person, or you do good deeds, No! The Bible makes it clear, if you want to accept Jesus as your Personal Saviour then it gets done on the basis of two things. These two things are critical because it will also help you on your work with the Lord and attain righteousness and a life pleasing to God.

Firstly, you have to confess with your mouth that Jesus is your Lord, this is very important because by your confession God will know and people in the world will know. This is significant because one does not hide a light under a bowl. Everyone must see and hear that you are a child of God.

And secondly you must believe in your heart, with your whole being and understanding that Jesus was raised from the dead and is alive and is your only Saviour.

So if you have read all of this and the Holy Spirit is directing you to accept Jesus as your Personal Saviour please pray the prayer on the next page, God loves you so much.

*“Is there no balm in Gilead? Is there no Physician there?”
Jeremiah 8:22*



IS THERE NO BALM IN GILEAD?

This question, posed in scripture centuries ago, continues to echo with striking relevance in contemporary society. Across communities, many grapple with unseen burdens (emotional wounds, fractured relationships, and a profound sense of spiritual disconnection). Despite advancements in various fields of knowledge and care, the need for deep, lasting restoration remains evident.

It is within this context that Fixing_Mind.Body.Spirit, a Christian movement founded by Mlungisi Cele and Nthabeleng Cele, has emerged as a response to this enduring question. Rooted in biblical truth and guided by a vision of holistic healing, the movement seeks to address the full spectrum of human need (mind, body, and spirit) through intentional teaching, community engagement, and practical support.

Foundation of the Movement Fixing_Mind.Body.Spirit was established on the conviction that true restoration cannot be fragmented. Rather, it must encompass the entirety of an individual's being. Spiritual renewal, emotional healing, and practical guidance are not isolated processes; they are interconnected dimensions of a single transformative journey.

From its inception, the movement has sought to create spaces where individuals are able to engage honestly with their lived realities. In these spaces, participants are encouraged not only to reflect on their circumstances but also to pursue meaningful change through both spiritual and practical avenues.

A distinguishing feature of the movement has been its recognition of the importance of collaboration between faith and professional support. Individuals requiring deeper intervention have been guided toward pastors

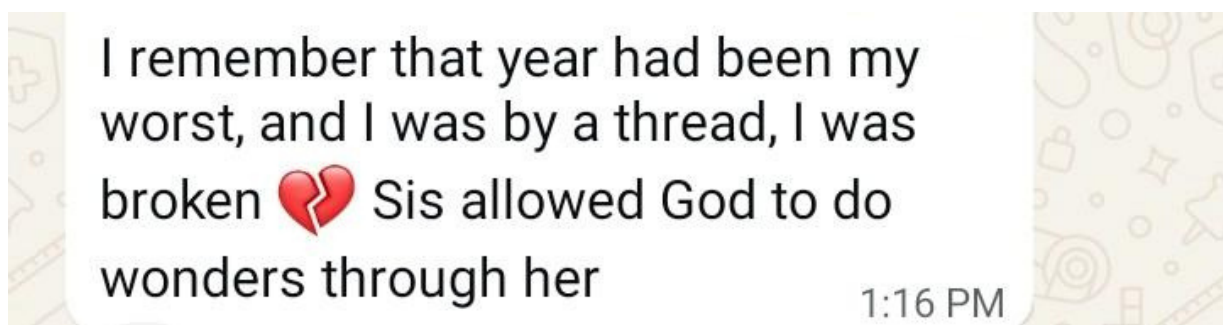

for spiritual counsel, as well as psychologists and other professionals for specialised care. This integrated approach underscores a commitment to responsible and sustainable transformation.

2023: A Call to Healing

The inaugural phase of the movement in 2023 centered on the theme of healing, drawing direct inspiration from the question posed in Jeremiah 8:22. “This came after we had undergone a period of healing as individuals and as a family. At that point, we realized we could share the knowledge we had gained during that journey, as many people were still in the place we once found ourselves in (a state of brokenness).” This phase was marked by a deliberate focus on confronting the realities of pain, whether emotional, psychological, or spiritual.

Participants were invited to move beyond avoidance and denial and instead engage in the processes necessary for restoration. Teachings emphasised the availability of healing through God, while also acknowledging the complexity of human experience. The response to this call was significant. Many individuals began to take deliberate steps toward addressing long-standing challenges. Some sought spiritual renewal through pastoral guidance, while others pursued professional assistance to navigate emotional and psychological difficulties.

Importantly, this phase also facilitated the reintegration of individuals who had withdrawn from their faith communities due to past hurt. Through compassionate engagement and sound teaching, participants found renewed confidence in reconnecting with God and with others. 2024: Alignment of Mind, Body, and Spirit Building on the foundation of healing, the focus in 2024 shifted toward alignment. Recognising that restoration must be sustained through intentional living, the movement introduced teachings centred on bringing the mind, body, and spirit into harmony under God's authority.

This phase encouraged participants to critically examine their patterns of thought, lifestyle choices, and spiritual disciplines. The aim was not merely behavioural modification, but a deeper transformation rooted in biblical principles. Discussions addressed key questions: what constitutes a renewed mind, how the body is to be stewarded as a temple, and the nature of a spiritually aligned life. These engagements fostered both reflection and practical application. As individuals embraced these principles, many reported increased clarity, stability, and a strengthened sense of direction. The emphasis on alignment served to reinforce the understanding that healing, while essential, is only the beginning of a broader journey toward wholeness.

2025: God's Blueprint for Marriage

In 2025, the movement extended its focus to interpersonal relationships, with particular emphasis on marriage. This progression reflected an understanding that individual transformation inevitably influences relational dynamics. Teachings during this period explored God's design for marriage, offering biblical perspectives on partnership, commitment, and

mutual responsibility. In a cultural context where relationship norms are often shaped by shifting societal values, this focus provided a framework grounded in scripture.

The teachings were intentionally inclusive, addressing both married individuals and those preparing for marriage. Participants were encouraged to approach relationships with intentionality, guided by principles that promote stability, respect, and shared purpose. The impact of this phase was evident in the reassessment and, in some cases, restoration of relationships. It also equipped individuals with the insight necessary to make informed and faith aligned decisions regarding their relational lives.

2026: Vision and Purpose

The current phase of the movement, in 2026, has been dedicated to the theme of vision. Having addressed healing, alignment, and relationships, the focus has now turned toward purpose and direction.

Participants are encouraged to seek clarity regarding their individual callings and to cultivate the discipline required to pursue them. This phase emphasises the importance of intentional living, guided by an awareness of divine assignment. The progression of themes over the years reveals a coherent trajectory: from healing to alignment, from alignment to relational wholeness, and ultimately to purposeful living. This reflects a comprehensive understanding of personal development within a faith context.

Impact and Ongoing Work

The work of Fixing_Mind.Body.Spirit is most clearly demonstrated through the experiences of those it has served. Individuals who had previously distanced themselves from their faith have returned with renewed commitment. Others have taken decisive steps toward personal growth, supported by both spiritual and professional resources. The movement's role as a connector - to pastors, counsellors, and supportive communities - has been instrumental in ensuring that participants are not left to navigate their journeys in isolation. This approach has contributed to outcomes that are both meaningful and sustainable.

Extending the Reach: Women Empowerment

In addition to the core activities of the movement, Nthabeleng Cele has undertaken a significant role in women empowerment initiatives. Through speaking engagements, she addresses issues of identity, healing, and purpose, providing encouragement and practical insight to diverse audiences. Her contributions have extended the reach of Fixing_Mind.Body.Spirit beyond its primary gatherings, creating additional platforms through which the movement's message can be shared.
